#### 1. SeaWorld® San Antonio Single Day Ticket

Single-day general admission to the SeaWorld® campus including access to regularly scheduled shows, Sesame Street® Bay of Play®, all amusement park rides and carnival games.

**Duration:** Approximately 5 hours

**Getting In:** VIP Line Privileges! Skip the ticket line! Head to the turnstiles with your mobile or printed pass.

**Notes:** You may experience a wait at the turnstiles. Photo ID is required at the time of redemption, and must match your pass. Admission may be refused if photo ID does not match the name on the pass. Your pass is non-transferable.

#### 2. Six Flags® Fiesta Texas

Ticket includes entrance to the park & all of its rides.

**Duration:** Approximately 8 hours

**Getting In:** Proceed straight to the Guest Relations office at the main park entrance to redeem your pass and receive a park ticket.

**Hours:** Park hours vary. Please visit park website for daily operating hours.

**Closings:** Dates and hours of operation are subject to change without notice. May be closed major U.S. holidays.

**Directions:** Six Flags Fiesta Texas is located just 15 minutes from downtown San Antonio: I-10 West and Loop 1604. Take exit 555, La Cantera Parkway.

**Public Transit:** You can board a VIA Metropolitan Transit bus to Six Flags Fiesta Texas from downtown

on Route 94 during park operation. Individuals may also board on Route 94 from Crossroads Mall on weekends. Passengers are dropped off just to the left of the park's main entrance. Call VIA Information at (210) 362-2020 for schedules.

### 3. Texas Hill Country & LBJ Ranch Tour

Tour admission to a one-day guided tour of Lyndon B. Johnson's boyhood home, the LBJ Ranch, & Texas Hill.

**Duration:** Approximately 7 hours.

**Reservations:** Reservations are required 24 hours in advanced. Call (800) 341-6000 and mention that you are a Go San Antonio Explorer pass holder. A credit card number will be needed to hold the reservation, but will not be charged unless you do not show up or cancel in advance of the tour.

**Notes:** Tour includes: Hotel pick-up at select downtown hotels and certain suburban hotels; Admission to the optional tour of LBJ's boyhood home & museum; free time to explore the grounds for yourself. Available at a slight additional cost: admission to the Nimitz Museum & the National Museum of the Pacific War, and Wine Tasting fees-if wine tasting option is chosen in advance. Please note, until further notice: Guided tours of the interior of the "Texas White House" are cancelled per the National Park Service due to needed repairs. However, guests can still explore the LBJ Ranch grounds, view exhibition pieces and artifacts in the JetStar Hangar, watch an award-winning 14-minute film, and get a picture with LBJ's infamous JetStar aka "Air Force One-Half".

### 4. iFLY Indoor Skydiving – 2 Flight Package + \$10 Merchandise Credit

Two, 1-minute flights + a \$10 merchandise credit and including a personalized flight certificate, flight gear rental, training, & personalized instruction during your flights.

**Reservations:** Reservations are required and are always subject to availability. Call (210) 762-4359 and mention that you are a San Antonio Explorer pass holder. Cancellations within 48-hours of flight time may be subject to re-booking fee. A credit card number will be needed to hold the reservation, but will not be charged unless you do not show up or cancel in advance of the flight.

**Getting In:** Present your pass and check in at the front desk.

**Notes:** Use of pass constitutes acceptance of Terms: may not be combined with other offers, discounts or packages. Participants must be at least 3 years of age and weigh less than 300 lbs. If weight exceeds 260 lbs, contact your iFLY location as additional restrictions and limitations may apply. Those who have had prior shoulder dislocation, heart/back issues or are pregnant should not fly. Before your flights, you will receive flight training from a certified flight instructor and learn proper body positioning and hand signals to use while flying. Next, you'll gear up with a helmet, flight suit, and goggles to get ready for your turn in the flight tunnel. When it's your turn to fly, your flight instructor will take you into the flight chamber and be with you during the whole flight experience to help you make the most of your time in flight. Each flight is equivalent to 1.5 free-fall skydives. May not be combined with other offers, discounts or packages. Participants must be at least 3 years of age and weigh less than 300 lbs. If

weight exceeds 260 lbs, contact your iFLY location as additional restrictions and limitations may apply. Those who have had prior shoulder dislocation, heart/back issues or are pregnant should not fly.

### 1. City Sightseeing Hop-On Hop-Off San Antonio Tour (24-Hour Ticket)

24-hour ticket featuring stops at the top San Antonio area attractions.

**Duration:** Approximately 2 hours without hopping-off or on.

**Getting In:** Present your pass to receive your boarding pass. Once you have your boarding pass, staff will inform you of pick-up locations.
