


## **How to acquire an invitation letter through the single digital portal of public administration in Greece – Gov.gr**


### **STEPS:**

1. Visit Website: <https://www.gov.gr/en/>
2. Choose: formal declaration
3. Next step: <https://www.gov.gr/en/piresies/polites-kai-kathemerinoteta/psephiaka-eggrapha-gov-gr/ekdose-upeuthunes-deloses>: issue a formal declaration by following the steps as shown in the pictures below:
